

## **CONCEPT NARRATIVE**

The "Ringer Park Portrait Garden" celebrates the Honorees with a transformative installation that links the stories of each honoree through a series of simple vertical trellis structures integrated with planting, narratives, and lighting. Visitors to the park are also invited to take self-portraits, or "selfies" with the sculptures, creating an engaging and interactive environment.

The pavement adjacent to each sculpture is engraved with biographical information and quotations to TELL THE STORY of each honoree. In addition, each portrait is spotlighted to enhance the night view and add needed light to the park.

**IDENTITY PYLONS** create gateways into the park. All elements are integrated with simple lights along the paths to enhance the evening experience and link the portraits and stories throughout the park.

Each sculpture will evolve over time as the plants fully engage the structure, providing a symbolic connection to the site and landscape. Each sculpture is semitransparent and can viewed from all sides, providing a changing view.

## LANDMARK DESTINATION



Scale: 1/4"=1'-0"




**OPTION 2:** FREESTANDING/WALL-MOUNTED SCULPTURES; PAVING TREATMENT
