ARTWORK - WELCOME CIRCLE













WELCOMING CIRCLE: At the top of the stairs, one enters an inviting circular gathering space with a ring of sculptural seating and artfully patterned paving. The seating, which is 19 feet in diameter, and cast in a pigmented concrete with integral inlay that complements the historic architecture, features graphic artwork depicting seasonal cycles of garden plantings and the names of the months in diverse languages spoken at the school.

COMMUNITY TABLE: A 28 foot long sculptural table will be inlaid with imagery of apples and historic recipes, inspiring shared meals. Students will be invited to design "heralds" with Wowhaus. The heralds, compositions of symbols emblematic of the unique history and diversity of the school, will be integrated into the benches.



Students will collaborate with Wowhaus to create Heralds that reflect the unique history & diversity of the Mather School.

Succotash (Means "Boiled Corn Kernels") Corn

> Shell Beans Summer Squash

Cut corn off cob; shell beans & cut up squash in chunks. Saute with onion & butter & cook until soft.

Colonial Dried Apples

Apples String

Core whole apples & peel them. Slice into rings and bang rings on string in  $\partial ry$  place for 5 weeks. Store in bags.

MATERIAL: CAST CONCRETE WITH INTEGRAL PIGMENTED CONCRETE INLAY
